
A LEGACY OF HOPE

ENGAGING PROGRAMS

Our goal is to increase access to **STEM Mentoring**, which provides youth ages 6-10 hands-on enrichment activities and career exploration, as well as **Workforce & Career Development** programs that help atrisk youth overcome barriers to high school graduation, secondary education and gainful employment.

FLEET & MOBILE CLUBS

A branded fleet of vehicles is vital to our commitment to make transportation available to Club members that would otherwise be unable to attend Club programs. Many of our families simply do not have the availability or financial means to provide their children transportation to Club activities after-school. In addition, vans ensure we can offer a variety of field trips and educational outings beyond the walls of our Club buildings.

Specially equipped RVs and vans will serve as **Mobile Club Sites** to ensure access to youth development programming and enrichment activities in rural areas where a standalone Club site may not be sustainable.
